Children's Choirs Minisingers is perfect introduction to music, singing and performance for children in years K - 2 with lots of fun action songs and musical games to develop skills in pitch and rhythm, concentration, co-ordination and memory. Wednesdays from 4:00 - 4:45pm.

Cantilena Singers is for students in years 3 – 6, who perform more complex unison melodies, 2 and 3-part songs and provides additional performance opportunities as they gain in confidence. Wednesdays 4:00 – 5:00pm.

Advanced Cantilena members also have the opportunity to join Cantilena Chorale, an extension choir following Cantilena rehearsals. Wednesdays 5:00 - 5:30pm.

Youth Choirs

New England Singers for students in years 7 – 12, provides talented and committed young singers opportunity to develop their musical skills in an inspiring environment focused on achieving excellence in performance. Mondays 4:00 - 5:15pm.

New England Chamber Choir is an extension choir offered to gifted and talented senior members of New England Singers who have achieved a high standard in music literacy, vocal production and performance skills. Mondays 5:15 – 6:00pm. Side by Side Choir for teenagers living with disability and their neurotypical peers is run through the Armidale Secondary College Support Unit.

Choral program members join for a whole year of activity, including weekly rehearsals during school terms, are guided by specialist music educators, and present concerts throughout the year.
